Join **Dana and Bob Fox** for a brief tour of some Chinese history, the Great Wall, and the Bei River.

Then it's off to the lonely grasslands of Manchuria: 300 Siberian Cranes en route to their breeding grounds, Red-crowned and White-Naped Cranes, and Oriental Storks on breeding territory – fantastic! Not to mention the vanishing Pallas's Bunting in Outer Mongolia, & Great Bustards.

Then 1000 miles to the west is the shinning Koko Nor Lake, gateway to the Tibetan Plateau, Himalayan Griffon hovering over an ancient Chinese Temple. Elliot's Laughing -thrush, the beautiful Bar-headed Goose, a "Gulag" Prison, 80 Yaks with snow-covered mountains behind, Eur-lag Pass and its temple, alpine plants and Blood Pheasants.
